



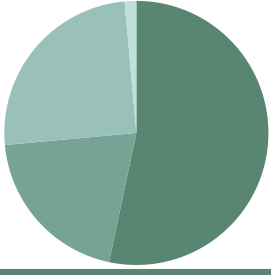

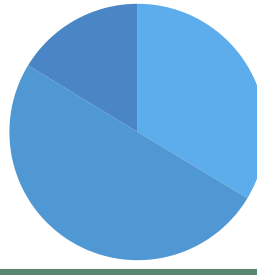
PRESIDENT'S LETTER

REVENUE & EXPENSES



Revenue

- Grants and Contributions: \$327,144 (50%)
- PPP Loan Forgiveness: \$124,040 (19%)
- In-Kind: \$153,610 (23.5%)
- Net Investment Income: \$49,371 (7.5%)



Expenses

- Programmatic: \$217,694 (33.63%)
- Admin & Governance: \$324,00 (50.06%)
- Fundraising: \$105,513 (16.31%)
