2018 Research Grant Awarded

The Foundation is pleased to announce the award of a **\$30,000 MTF Research Grant to Kelly Tanner, PhD, OTR/L, at Nationwide Children's Hospital**, Columbus OH, for her study, ***Effect of Massage Therapy on Opiate Use in the Hospital-Based Pediatric Population.***



The study will explore the role of and evidence for massage therapy (MT) in treating pain in pediatric patients admitted to a pediatric hospital. It will describe the extent of consultations and utilization of MT in a large, urban, Midwestern, freestanding, pediatric hospital, and then determine the extent to which MT reduces use of opioid pain medication during hospital admissions.

**This research will help establish baseline demographics for a hospital-based pediatric population while advancing MT as an alternative to opioid use in this population.**
