New Blog: Massage for Cancer Center Staff 2019 Community Service Grant

Learn more about MTF's 2019 Community Service Grant award to the University of Maryland Baltimore Foundation Inc., for its project, **Seated Massages to Decrease Burnout and Compassion Fatigue in Cancer Center Staff.**

This grant will provide up to 288 seated massage sessions to nurses and other staff members at the University of Maryland Greenebaum Cancer Center. **A pilot study conducted in 2010 found that offering 10-minute seated massages to nurses during working shifts significantly reduced stress-related symptoms and anxiety.** Data will be collected over the course of this project which may also contribute to future research.
