



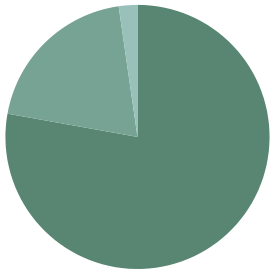

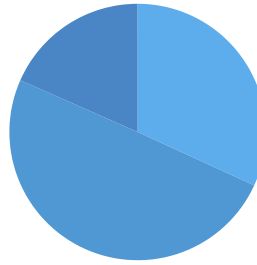
PRESIDENT'S LETTER

Revenue

- Grants and Contributions: \$482,987 (77.8%)
- In-Kind: \$123,528 (19.9%)
- Net Investment Income: \$14,144 (2.3%)



Expenses

- Programmatic: \$199,784 (31.8%)
- Admin & Governance: \$312,303 (49.8%)
- Fundraising: \$115,391 (18.4%)
